About the Club:

- The club is situated at the Ridley Mill end of Guessburn, which is opposite the station. We have four all weather/synthetic grass courts with floodlights and a modern pavilion. Keys for the courts and pavilion can be purchased from the treasurer.
- In the 2009 season we had 81 senior members and 93 junior members. Teams are entered in the Northumberland, Durham & Cleveland leagues in all categories; ladies, mens, veterans and juniors.
- Coaching courses are offered for juniors and can be arranged according to demand for other categories of membership.
- The club holds various social events and tournaments, including club championships, throughout the season.

Juniors: Our coach is Sarah Stevenson (07984 804299). Sarah offers a full programme for juniors including a club night for the over 10s. Juniors have first use of the courts, Mondays to Fridays after school until 7.00pm, (6.00pm when there is a senior match), and 3 courts on Saturday until 2.00pm. On Sunday afternoons the courts are available for juniors and family groups. Some matches may be scheduled for this time.

Recognised tennis footwear should be worn and the membership cards issued must be carried at all times. Keys to the court can be obtained from Mrs F Scott, 83 Guessburn or Mr I Gray, 67 Guessburn and should be returned immediately after opening the gate.

Court times: At the times shown specific groups have priority during the summer season. Junior times are indicated above.

Home matches are generally scheduled for Tuesday and Wednesday evenings when 3 courts will normally be required. Dates are displayed in membership cards and on the notice board.

At all times, where there are spare courts, these are available for general play. Juniors are asked to be particularly aware of court behaviour when playing in adult time.
